

## **A brief report on activities of the Electronic Publishing Committee**

The Committee was not very active since its meeting in September which is primarily its chair's failure.

The main effort has been made to finalize the EuDML Initiative Statutes and to establish the association. Unfortunately, despite the repeated reminders, three of twelve signatures are still missing: the Ionian University in Corfu, the Interdisciplinary Centre for Mathematical and Computational Modelling in Warsaw and the University Joseph Fourier in Grenoble. All three have been reminded again but the signatures did not arrive to this date.

The EPC chair sent a supporting letter to the project of Repository & Publishing Platform to be developed by FIZ Karlsruhe.

Eugenio Rocha was to take part as EPC representative in the Publications Committee meeting in Ljubljana in November. The main task was to discuss the possible overlaps between both committees and a distribution of tasks. For unforeseen reasons, Eugenio had to cancel his travel at the very last moment and it was too late to arrange for a replacement.
